

Twisted Mittens

These are very simple mittens, done using mostly single crochet. The body of the mitten is worked in spiral rounds and comes together very quickly.

The cuff is made with cables that “twist” on the wrist for fun. I used 1 skein of Red Heart Boutique, Unforgettable for the sample in photos.

Hook size: 5.5 mm &
4.5mm (for thumb)

Yarn weight: 4

Yardage: 280 yard skein

Round 7	1sc in each stitch around DO NOT JOIN WITH SL ST. This is where you start the spiral body of the mitten. Continue to the end of R18.	2sc in next st, 1sc in next 6sts (3 times), join to first sc with sl st (mark with stitch marker) (24sts all the way to cuff)	2sc in next st, 1sc in next 6sts (3 times), join to first sc with sl st
Round 8	(keep going...)	1sc in each stitch around DO NOT JOIN WITH SL ST. This is where you start the spiral body of the mitten. Continue to the end of R19.	2sc in next st, 1sc in next 7sts (3 times), join to first sc with sl st (mark with stitch marker) (27sts all the way to cuff)

Round 9	(keep going...)	(keep going...)	1sc in each stitch around DO NOT JOIN WITH SL ST. This is where you start the spiral body of the mitten. Continue to the end of R20.
	Round 1 to the Thumbhole Rounds make up the length of the glove from the tip of the fingers to the mid-palm. Add MORE ROUNDS HERE if you are accommodating longer fingers.

Round 28	Sc around, sc decrease in last two sts: insert hook into next st, YO, pull through, insert hook into next st, YO, pull through, YO, pull through all loops on hook. You've just decreased the stitch count by 1 so that the cuff rows are perfect for working in a spiral round. (20sts here and for remainder of pattern)		
Round 29	CUFF: BpDc around next st, sc in next st (11 times)		
Round 30	BEGIN SPIRAL WORK: Sc in next st (top of BpDc), BpDc around same BpDc (repeat around)	Sc around, sl st into last st (24sts)	
Round 31	Sc in next st (top of BpDc), BpDc around same BpDc (repeat around)	CUFF: BpDc around next st, sc in next st (12 times) (24sts for remainder of pattern)	
Round 32	Sc in next st (top of BpDc), BpDc around same BpDc (repeat around)	BEGIN SPIRAL WORK: Sc in next st (top of BpDc), BpDc around same BpDc (repeat around)	Sc around, sc decrease in last two sts: insert hook into next st, YO, pull through, insert hook into next st, YO, pull through, YO, pull

Round 37			Sc in next st (top of BpDc), BpDc around same BpDc (repeat around), sl st in next st, finish off.
Thumb Notes	Drop hook size one full millimeter. There are 12 stitches surrounding the thumbhole (The five on top and the five on the bottom and the two on either side of the opening). Work single crochets into these stitches building up the thumb length working in spirals.		
Thumb Round 1	Insert hook into front of fabric and toward the thumbhole opening, this will ensure that your thumb stitches are also right facing, sc into each of the 12 stitches.		
Thumb Round 2 through (11, 12 or 13)	Sc into top of first sc from Round 1, sc in continuous rounds until you have completed 11-13 rows, depending on length of thumb. Cut yarn, leave a tail at least 3 inches long so that you can loop in through every other stitch in the last Round and cinch the thumb closed, weave in end.
