## Twisted Mittens

These are very simple mittens, done using mostly single crochet. The body of the mitten is worked in spiral rounds and comes together very quickly.

The cuff is made with cables that "twist" on the wrist for fun. I used 1 skein of Red Heart Boutique, Unforgettable for the sample in photos.
